The Dr. William J. and Alicia A. McEniry Scholarship will be awarded to a current senior student and/or graduate of Ashton-Franklin Center High School who is entering the Animal or Human Health/Medical field. Primary consideration for awarding the \$1,000 scholarship will be given to financial need, extracurricular and community involvement and response to the essay question. GPA is a secondary consideration. This scholarship can be applied for and awarded to the recipient for four years. A committee comprised of school personnel will select the scholarship recipient. The scholarship is paid (50%) at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters. In late August-early September, the student needs to submit a copy of the first semester bill, class schedule and verification of major to receive half payment of the scholarship award. Second payment will be made in early January after the student submits a copy of their first semester grades, verification of major and second semester bill and class schedule.
